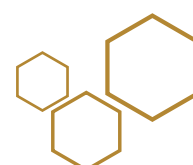

Introduction

Therefore, the focus has always been on how to set a model in the process of coordination between the legislative and executive authorities to establish the government of the future.

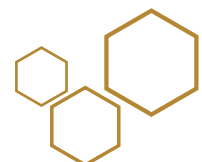
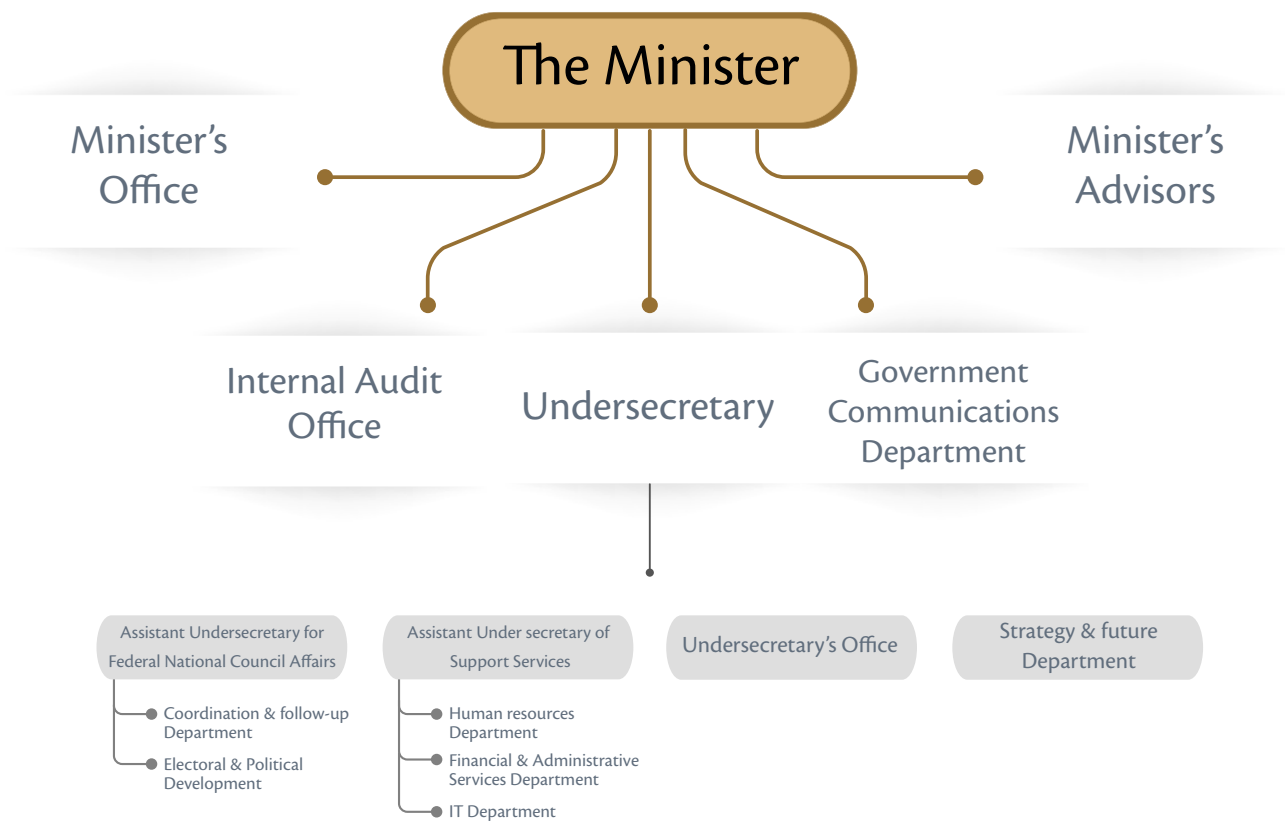
The Ministry is keen to enhance confidence between the government and the Federal National Council and to strengthen the relationship between the legislative and executive authorities through the coordination and information Department. The department works to establish common ground between the Government and the Federal National Council in terms of opinions by holding regular meetings between representatives of the Government and the Speaker of the Federal National Council and between the Ministry and General Secretariat of the Federal National Council, in addition to regular meetings that bring together representatives of federal government entities and the representatives of the General Secretariat of the Federal National Council.

The Ministry has also set up organizational bodies and units to promote coordination between the two authorities by assigning trained and qualified coordinators in all ministries who are capable of dealing with and coordinating matters relating to the Federal National Council. The Ministry has established specialized management to promote the culture of political participation, it is called the management of political development and it seeks to spread and entrench the concept of political participation among citizens.

To achieve that, innovative initiatives were launched and periodic activities were organized to spread political awareness and highlight the achievements of the Federal National Council in all fields among members of society, making optimal use of all influential communication channels available to them in a manner tailored to the nature of the United Arab Emirates and its political, economic, social and cultural specificities. The Ministry of State for Federal National Council Affairs, works as the General Secretariat of the National Election Committee and the Election Management Committee, which is responsible for organizing elections for the Federal National Council. In the context, The Ministry made great efforts to organize all aspects of FNC elections (human, legal, logistical, etc.).

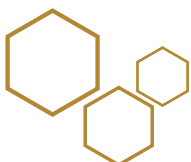


Strategic plan 2019

Improving the efficiency and effectiveness of cooperation and coordination between the Government and the Federal National Council.

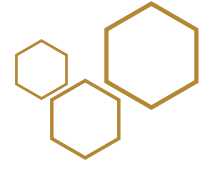

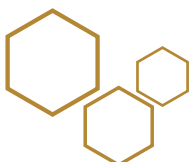


Achievements

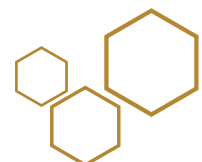
The ministry focused on preparing for government representation and the attendance of ministers at FNC sessions to discuss a general topic or bill . In proactive initiatives such as the coordination service and the historical profile service, the Ministry has been proactive in forecasting and submitting data that may be needed by the relevant Minister prior to their request, based on an understanding of their reporting, data and statistical needs. In 2019, the attendance of Ministers to the Council to discuss a general topic or a data law was 100%.



The Ministry has sought to involve the coordinators of ministries and federal institutions in the design and development of coordination and follow-up processes. To this end, it has organized an annual meeting and dialogue in the presence of the coordinators of the ministries and Federal National Council to discuss working mechanisms. The problems were clearly identified and appropriate solutions were found to meet the needs and expectations.

Every year the Ministry publishes the Journal of Political Participation, which is characterized by an elegant style of language and a depth of content that caters to all sections of society. It contains a variety of articles highlighting the importance of promoting political awareness in society, a comprehensive dossier on e-voting and its importance to the electoral process, and a variety of other topics



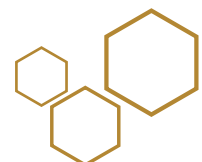
The ministry organized the activities of the eighth session of the Political Awareness Forum for University Students, which is an important and main platform for communicating with young people, promoting political culture among them , and activating their participation in parliamentary work in the UAE that is in the line with the national agenda of the United Arab Emirates to strengthen national identity among citizens.

The Forum is also an interactive platform that promotes political concepts among young people, who make-up a large part of the electoral colleges, through the development of strategies for political awareness among young university students, which play a great role in promoting loyalty and belonging to the country.

The forum included two major sessions, the first of which focused on the topic of youth and FNC elections. His Excellency Tariq Hilal Lootah, Under secretary of the Ministry of State for Federal National Council Affairs, Member of the National Election Committee and Chair of its Election Management Committee, spoke on the management of the parliamentary elections. The role of students in elections was addressed by Dr.Souad El-Arabi, professor of sociology at the United Arab Emirates University.

The session was moderated by Dr. Mohammed bin Hoyden, Head of the Department of Government and Society at UAE University. The second session, titled Women and the Empowerment of the Federal National Council, was addressed by H.E Dr. Saeed Mohammed Al Ghufli, MFNCA's Assistant Undersecretary of FNC Affairs, Member and Rapporteur of the National Election Committee on the subject of the political empowerment program launched by His Highness Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan, President of the UAE in 2005 , and representation of women in the Federal National Council.

Professor Ahlam Saeed Al-Lamki, Director of the Research and development department of the General Women's Union, spoke about the campaign of Her Highness Sheikha Fatima Bint Mubarak, President of the General Women's Union, Supreme Chairperson of the Family Development Foundation, President of the Supreme Council for Motherhood and Childhood. The session was moderated by Dr. Abdullah Suleiman, Director, Department of Political Development, Ministry of State for Federal National Council Affairs.

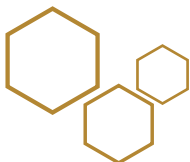


As the General Secretary of the National Election Committee 2019, the ministry, through its chairmanship of the Electoral Management Committee of the National Election Committee , worked to organize all aspects of the electoral process (human, legal, technical, logistical and administrative) and developed a legal framework for the Federal National Council elections, launching the executive instructions for the Federal National Council elections, as well as various electronic systems to facilitate and organize all processes and procedures, including electronic voting and registration systems candidates, equipping of electoral centers, community awareness lectures, and management of volunteers.

For the first time in the country's history, the Ministry prepared the legal framework for elections to the Federal National Council, consisting of the Executive Regulations for the FNC Elections which were approved by the National Election Committee. Various electronic systems have been developed to facilitate and regulate all processes and procedures, including:

- Electronic system for dealing with electoral environments
- Electronic candidate system
- Electronic campaign monitoring system
- Electronic voting system
- Winners Announcement system

In this regard , the Ministry has made a number of achievements, both in dealing with elections and incoordinating the appointment of members of the Federal National Council.

The Ministry develops and improves its internal and external services and operations based on the best global standards and ensures that all institutional requirements of government are met at all levels of the Ministry.

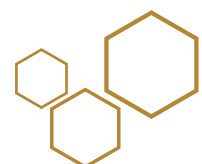


Achievements

The Ministry of State for Federal National Council Affairs was awarded the 2019 Stevie Silver Award. in the category of “Best Human Resource Management “, beating out more than 4000 global government and private institutions from 74 countries.

The Ministry of State Federal National Council Affairs was awarded as the best human resource team in the GCC. This was done during the Gulf Government Human Resources Awards, 2019 held during the seventh session of the Government Human Resources Summit in the presence of a number of individuals and human resource managers in the region.

The ministry received a gold rating from the Human Resources Investors Foundation, which was evaluated by the Ministry of State as part of its participation in the British organization Investors In People. The first stage is aimed at measuring the level of enterprises investing in their human resources, which assesses the Ministry’s performance on all the requirements for certification of human resources investors. Assessment of the Ministry continues in a series of stages towards the achievement of the target.





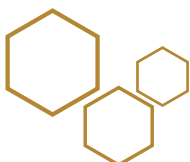
The Ministry has achieved the second best performance in human resource management on the HR Maturity Index in Federal Government standards, which has a new mechanism for measuring the development and maturity of human resource management competence and practices in Federal Government institutions.

The ministry has achieved a top ranking and become the second best federal authority in happiness, quality of life, loyalty and employee engagement, according to the results of the happiness survey of all federal agencies. This result followed the implementation of an integrated system of initiatives and projects that pursued the government's goals.

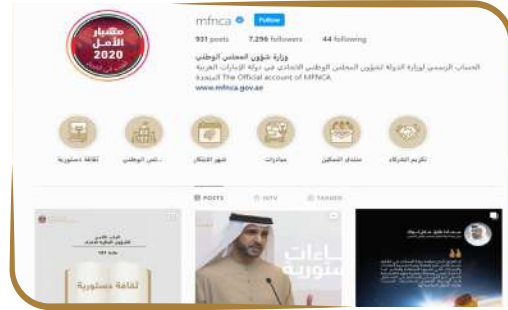


The Ministry applies international standards in its operations, including quality management specifications (ISO9001:2015).

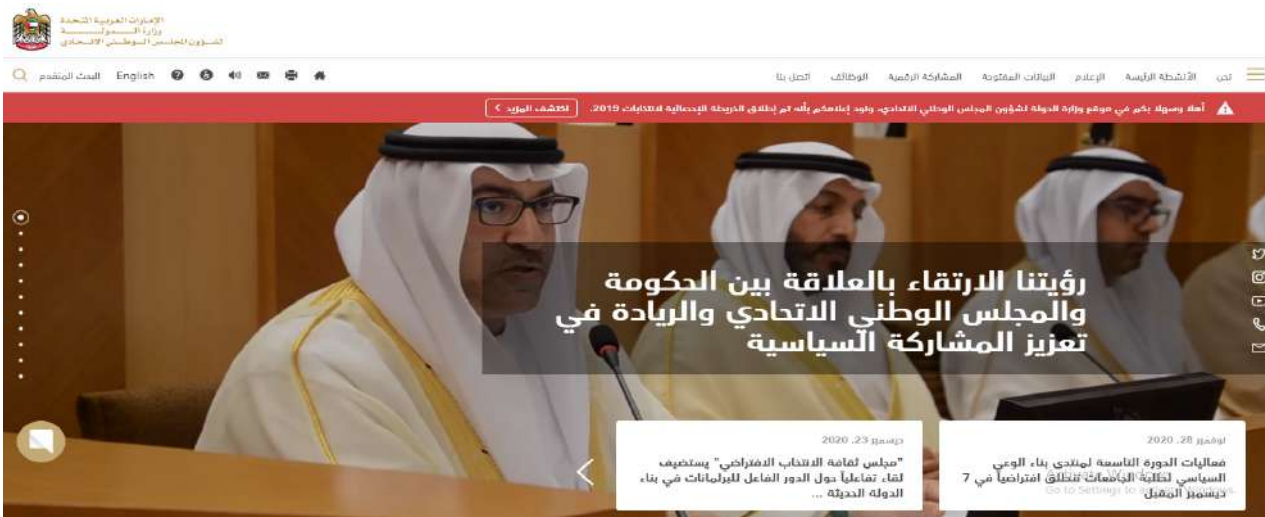

The Ministry has developed an integrated and effective internal and external communication system in support of its strategic plan. The methodology ensures 100% coverage of the Ministry's activities.

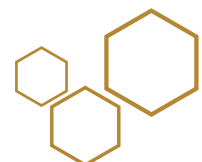

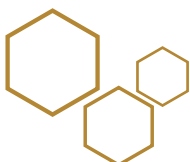

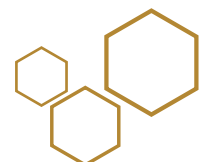
Achievements

The Ministry works to develop the creativity and innovation skills of government employees by enabling them to learn the latest innovation tools and use them to develop organizational performance through various courses and workshops. The aim is to impart knowledge and sharpen the skills of the employees.



The ministry held a patent for implementing an intelligent system to attract talent and job seekers at job fairs. The integration of this system helps to significantly reduce the time, effort and cost of managing human resources and identifying and selecting the best qualified talent in line with international best practices.

The Ministry organizes a series of workshops and brainstorming sessions to engage with the creative and intellectual groups in society. The main issues related to its areas of work are presented and divided into a series of topics that are discussed separately in order to come up with a set of creative and innovative ideas that meet their desires and aspirations.



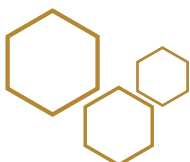


The Ministry, as part of its participation in UAE Innovation Month, has launched several innovative initiatives to promote awareness about the culture of political participation and representative life in the society. The Ministry launched the You in the Federal National Council application, which simulates the real-life experience of attending one of the sessions of the Federal National Council and following the government's interaction with the FNC council members' questions through audio and video clips of the discussions via virtual reality glasses.

The application aims to enrich the knowledge of society about the nature of parliamentary life in the UAE to inform them about the work of the Federal National Council and the efforts of the Ministry of State for Federal National Council Affairs to strengthen coordination and cooperation between the legislative and executive authorities for the benefit of the nation and its citizens.

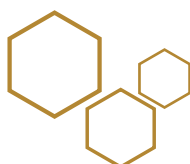
A glimpse of the UAE's performance in global competitiveness reports in 2019 among indicators relevant to the Ministry's areas of work.

The UAE ranks first in the world in terms of women's representation in parliament on the Government Competence metric of the annual competitiveness review, issued by the International Institute for Development's world competition center. This achievement is a global recognition of the Decision made by His Highness Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan, President of the UAE, to raise the representation of women in the FNC to 50%. The international parliamentary union praises the progress made by the United Arab Emirates in the areas of empowerment of women in parliament. The United Arab Emirates is among the top four countries in the world in terms of women's representation in parliament, where 50% of the FNC was made up of women at the beginning of its 17th Legislative Chapter in November 14, 2019. This is due to the tremendous support women receive from H.H. Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan, President of the UAE.

In its report, the inter-parliamentary union valued the participation of women in the elections to the Federal National Council held in October 2019, adding that the largest increase in the number of women parliamentarians was in the parliamentary elections held in 02/2019 with the United Arab Emirates in the lead and followed by Dominican Republic and Uzbekistan.

The Edelman Trust Barometer 2019 has ranked the UAE as the second most trusted government in the world. This reflects the progress that places the country in advanced ranks over a number of countries in the world. The leadership's keenness to support all development projects and to strengthen national cohesion between the leadership and the people.

The UAE ranked second globally on the Government Efficiency index in the Global Competitiveness Report 2019 issued by the World Economic Forum (Davos), and came in first place globally in the Efficiency of Implementing Government Decisions sub-index, as well as the second place globally on the flexibility of Government policies index.

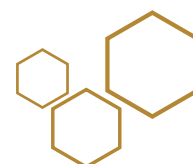
